### Customer Charter Points.

- We are committed to our Health and Safety responsibilities to provide a safe environment for staff, members, guests, visitors and any other person that might be affected by our undertaking.
- We will ensure that all Health and Safety matters are taken seriously, addressed promptly and that there is means of communication for everyone to report and discuss issues or concerns.
- We will, insofar as is reasonably practicable, ensure that identifiable risks are adequately controlled by employing safe systems of work. We will continually assess these risks and measures to promote Health & Safety compliance.
- Members of MGC, guests and visitors are reminded that they are responsible for their own health and safety and that of others whilst on the premises including the golf course; we ask that due consideration is given to this when playing golf, walking around or playing the course, driving buggies and using the driving range.
- We expect members, guests and visitors to adhere to warning notices, avoid areas undergoing maintenance, use designated pathways, steps, ramps and apply appropriate levels of diligence with regard to health and safety whilst on the golf course.

As with all physical sports, there is some level of risk taken by participants and to that end we expect members, guests and visitors to comply with the above points regarding the Health and Safety objectives of MGC, thus reducing risk to an absolute minimum.
